



MAJESTIC MOBILE PROJECT

In the Fall of 2007, the Majestic Theater's Founding Executive Director, Jeffrey Gabel, attended a regional theater conference where he met Washington, D.C. artist Kevin Reese. They agreed to do an artist-in-residency project where 250 Gettysburg elementary students would help Reese create a monumental mobile to be permanently installed in the theater's art gallery ceiling space.

The project kicked into high gear a year later when Gettysburg Lincoln Elementary School and the Adams County Arts Council signed on as partners, and Gabel secured project funding from the international LEGO Children's Fund, and the Rotary Club of Gettysburg. Reese's week-long residency took place in April 2009 and culminated on the Majestic's stage where a three-part mobile spanning 17 feet was unveiled before a standing ovation from 450 students, teachers, and parents.
